The Easy Lap Band is not permanent, and can be reversed by removing the silicone band from around the stomach. Gastric bypass, on the other hand is a permanent surgical procedure.

If your doctor can prove that weight loss surgery is a medical necessity, your health insurance will cover the Easy Lap Band procedure. A BMI of 40 or over is the first qualification. If you have a BMI under 40 and an obesity-related medical condition such as diabetes your insurance may still pay for the operation. If you are having trouble getting your insurance to pay for the Easy Lap Band, you can always apply for a loan.
